On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Document, EPA has reregistered the product listed above. With regards to labeling, you must make the labeling changes listed below:

1. Revise the Precautionary Statement to read:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin.
 Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

2. Add the Practical Treatment which reads:

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

If in Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

3. Revise the Storage and Disposal Statement so that it provides instructions for both Commercial and Homeowner Use:

a. The Storage and Disposal Statement for Commercial use must read as follows:

Storage: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Store in a cool dry place. Do not store where children or animals may gain access.

Pesticide Disposal: Waste resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Disposal: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

b. The Storage and Disposal Statement for Homeowner Use must read as follows:

Storage: Store in a cool dry place. Do not store where children or animals may gain access.

Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

4. Submit two copies of the revised printed labeling of the commercial and residential use labels before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

This action is taken under the authority of Section 4(g)(2)(c) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for control reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

RESIDENTIAL

Apply powder by using handy squeeze bottle or by using a teaspoon. Blow or scatter liberally under and behind range, refrigerator, dishwasher, washing machine and dryer. Remove all lower cabinet drawers in the bath and kitchen. Scatter liberally in drawer wells. Spread 1/2 teaspoon in each corner of shelves. Any powder visible after application should be brushed into cracks and crevices, or removed. Re-apply as necessary.

COMMERCIAL AND

NEW CONSTRUCTION APPLICATIONS

Use in walls, soffits, sub cabinet voids, behind long banks of appliances or lockers. Blow into pits under dumb waiters and under booth seats. Apply under pallets and behind boxes in storerooms. Blow around baseboard areas and around pipes.

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS

Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed, prepared or served. **FOOD AREAS—APPLICATION LIMITED TO CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY.** Includes areas of receiving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing) preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Serving areas (when food is exposed and facility is in operation also would be considered a food area). Apply in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using the handy squeeze bottle. Apply in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases to control cockroach infestations. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

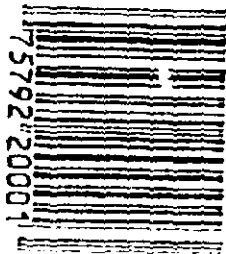
