12 Point----- DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Type Thoroughly clean areas before disinfecting. Always dilute before using.  
FOR THE SICK ROOM - wash all utensils such as bedpans, urinals, etc. with a solution of 3-oz. of disinfectant to a gallon of water  
TO DEODORIZE WATER CLOSETS AND URINALS, use 4-Oz. of disinfectant to a gallon of water. Apply freely to all surfaces to be disinfected.  
FOR GENERAL DISINFECTING - remove all soil from the area and use a solution of one part of disinfectant to 10 parts water. Wash and mop over entire area to be cleaned.

THIS DISINFECTANT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED FOR GENERAL HOSPITAL SANITATION INCLUDING FLOORS AND WALLS. EFFECTIVE AGAINST TYPHOID COCCUS, ALGAE AND SALMONELLA SPECIES.

18 Point---WARRANTY  
Type Not to be used internally. Do not allow DURACIDE HOSPITAL DISINFECTANT to come in contact with foods. Do not mix with other sanitizers.

12 Point Type
