The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with the Label Improvement Program Notice for Antimicrobial Products Used as Food Contact Surface Sanitizers, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.
 - a. Delete the word "milk."
 - b. Delete the statement "General Classification."
 - c. The precautionary statements on the side panel should read as follows:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals
DANGER

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed.

Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Avoid contamination of food. Remove and wash contaminated clothing.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

- d. Under the "Hospital and Restaurant Use" heading the contact time is 10 minutes for the Disinfection section and not 1 minute.
- e. Revise the "Poultry Houses and Equipment" heading to read "Poultry Houses and Equipment Disinfectant."
- f. The "Keep Out of Reach of Children" statement must appear directly above the signal word "Danger" (center panel only).
- g. Include the "Storage and Disposal" heading for the Disposal section.
- h. Refer to PR Notice 83-3 for acceptable "Storage and Disposal" statements.

Refer to the enclosure "The Label" for labeling type size requirements and formatting.

- 2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.


Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT
IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING

FOR SANITIZING GLASSES AND DRINKING UTENSILS IN BARS & RESTAURANTS: Empty glasses and pre-flush if necessary, then wash wares with a non-ionic detergent followed by a potable water rinse before sanitizing. Immerse wares for 1 minute in a sanitizing solution of 2 tablets in 1 gallon of water (approx. 200 ppm), then drain solution from wares and air dry. Prepare new solution daily or more often if solution becomes diluted or soiled. Do not use with soap or anionic detergents. Replace cover after use. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and put in trash.
