The product is intended for sanitizing glasses and drinking utensils in bars and restaurants. The diluted product will contain 200 pp, therefore the use of goggles, face shield, and rubber gloves is not required. So therefore, on the labeling under the subheading " Precautionary Statement" delete the words " wear goggles, or face shield and rubber gloves when handling". In the "Statement of Practical Treatment" section, delete the following phrases "egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available drink" from the labeling.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

If these conditions are not complies with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6. Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
