The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(a) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) as amended, is acceptable with the following conditions:

**Proposed Amendment**

- Update First Aid Statements per PR Notice 2001

**Label Comments**

- Based on the acute toxicity data for similar products revise the "Precautionary Statements" as follows:

**CORROSIVE**, Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. Maybe fatal if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear protective eyewear (goggles, face shield, or safety glasses) and protective clothing when handling. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse

- Revise the "First Aid" statement to include the following:  
**IF INHALED** Moved person to fresh to fresh air. If person is not breathing call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison center or doctor for further treatment advice.

**Pesticide Disposal**



**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT  
IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING

**FOR SANITIZING AND DEODORIZING IN BARS AND RESTAURANTS** of Glasses, Tableware and Cooking Ware. Remove gross food particles and soil by pre-rinse, or pre-scrape and, when necessary, pre-soak treatment. Then wash wares with a good detergent followed by a potable water rinse before sanitizing. Immerse wares in the sanitizing rinse for 1 minute then drain solution from wares and air dry. Prepare sanitizing solution by adding one ounce of SQB-550 to 4 gallons of water. This will provide 200 ppm of active ingredient. Prepare new solution daily or more often if solution becomes diluted or soiled. Do not use in conjunction with soap or anionic detergent.

**FOR SANITIZING AND DEODORIZING OF DAIRY AND MILK PROCESSING EQUIPMENT**, clean and rinse thoroughly, then immerse for 2 minutes in a solution made with one ounce of this product in 4 gallons of water (approx. 200 ppm). Air dry.

**FOR SANITIZING AND DEODORIZING OF EQUIPMENT IN FOOD AND MEAT PROCESSING PLANTS**, clean and rinse thoroughly. Then scrub with a solution of one ounce in 3 gallons of water (approx. 250 ppm). Flush equipment with clear water before reusing.

**FOR INANIMATE OBJECTS** in hospitals including floors, urinals, lavatories, hoppers and the operating room, add one ounce to one gallon of water and apply freely over surfaces to be treated after cleaning.

**FOR MOLD CONTROL OF WALLS AND CEILINGS IN FOOD PLANTS**, clean thoroughly, rinse, then spray surfaces until moist or sponge with a solution containing one ounce of this product per gallon of water. Repeat as necessary to maintain control.
