DANGER

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING

FOR USE IN RESTAURANTS AND BARS on Glasses, Dishes, Kitchen Wares, Coffee Urns, Knives, Forks, and Spoons. (Do not use on Sterling Silver or Silver Plate).

Remove gross food particles and soil by pre-flush, or pre-scrape and, when necessary, pre-soak treatment. Then wash wares with a good detergent followed by a potable water rinse before sanitizing. Immerse wares in the sanitizing rinse for 1 minute then drain solution from wares and air dry. Prepare sanitizing solution by adding 9.51 grams (Approx. 1 tablespoon) of Lue-San to 3 gallons of water. This will provide 100 ppm of available chlorine. Do not allow concentration to fall below 50 ppm. Consult your local health department to be sure of ppm of available chlorine and contact time required. Prepare new solution daily or more often if solution becomes diluted or soiled.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from direct sunlight or heat. In case of spill, flood area with large quantities of water. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard by placing in trash collection or burying it in approved landfill area. Do not contaminate food by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.
