The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with the conditions listed below:

- Revised "First Aid" statement Per PR Notice 2001-1
- Addition of a "Toll-Free" hot line telephone number
- · Change in source of the active ingredient

Conditions

- 1. Delete the phrase "Nominal Concentration" from the Ingredient Statement.
- 2. Update the "First Aid" statement as follows:

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING

FOR SANITIZING TABLEWARE IN LOW TEMPERATURE DISHWASHING MACHINE: Dispense CHLO-CIDE into final rinse water at 100ppm. available chlorine. Do not allow concentration to fall below 50ppm. Air dry. Dispenser should be set to deliver 6cc of CHLO-CIDE per gallon of water to give 100 ppm. of available chlorine. Only a qualified service representative should set or adjust dispenser on the machine.
