On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

Based on your response to the Reregistration Eligibility Document, EPA has reregistered the above named product subject to the comments recorded in the succeeding paragraph. This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g)(2)(C) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended. Reregistration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of your product.

Make the following labeling changes before you release the product for shipment:

1. The Child Resistant Packaging is Required.
2. Include the word "Poison" and the skull and crossbones symbol immediately below the signal word "DANGER" on the front panel of the label.

3. Revise the "Precautionary Statement" to read:

Fatal if inhaled. Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage or skin burns. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not breathe dust. Wear goggles or face shield. For handling activities, use dust/mist filtering respirator (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-21C). Wear protective clothing and rubber gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse.

5. Under the "Statement of Practical Treatment" revise the "If Swallowed" to read:

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.


6. The proposed label should contain a "Note to Physicians". Some suggested types of information include the following:

- technical information on symptomatology;
- use of supportive treatments to maintain life functions;
- medicine that will counteract the specific physiological effects of the pesticide;
- company telephone number to specific medical personnel who can provide specialized medical advice.

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT (FIRST AID)

IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Reentry into treated swimming pools/spas is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm.

#### INITIAL TREATMENT:

1. Check pH of pool with a Poolchem Test Kit. Adjust pH if needed with Pool Trol pH Plus or Pool Trol pH Minus.
2. Add 1 oz. of Pool Trol Chloro-Pure for every 500 gallons of pool water.
3. Add Pool Trol Chlorine Stabilizer using 1-1/2 lbs. for every 5,000 gals. of water. Add Pool Trol Chlorine Stabilizer after chlorine residual has been checked with a Poolchem Test Kit. There is no need to add Pool Trol Chlorine Stabilizer after initial treatment.

#### HOW TO MAINTAIN PROPER CHLORINE LEVEL

Chlorine level should be maintained at 0.6 to 1.0 ppm (parts per million) of available chlorine as determined by a test kit. After initial treatment (see above), add 2-1/2 oz. per 5,000 gals. of water as needed. Check pool water daily with a Poolchem Test Kit to advise you of the need for adding Pool Trol Chloro-Pure. Maintain the proper pH of 7.2 to 7.6 for optimum results. In hot water, or where many people use the pool, it may be necessary to increase the quantities used.

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

##### PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

**STRONG OXIDIZING AGENT.** Mix only with water. Use clean, dry utensils. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases, and possible generation of fire and explosion. In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reuse container. Isolate container, if possible, in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water to dissolve all material before discarding container.

##### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish and other aquatic organism. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance, contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

##### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.  
**CONTAINER DISPOSAL:** Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat and open flame. In case of decomposition, do not reuse container. Isolate container, if possible, in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water to dissolve all material before discarding this container. Do not reuse empty container, but place in trash collection.
