Subject: Amendment - Updated Formula, Revised Labeling  
Permanent Algacide  
EPA Registration No. 3525-34  
Your Submission Dated August 6, 1986

Revised labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable provided you:

1. Make the following changes before releasing the product for shipment bearing amended labeling:
  - a. Change "Hazardous" to "Hazards" in the heading Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals.
  - b. Under Environmental Hazards, delete "Do not discharge . . . for guidance, contact your Regional Office . . ." and add "Do not apply to water except as specified on labeling."
  - c. Under Storage and Disposal, delete reference to disposal of rinsate in a sanitary sewer. Such guidelines for rinsate disposal are not appropriate for this product.
2. Submit one (1) copy of final printed labeling incorporating the changes above.

A stamped copy of labeling is enclosed for your records.




