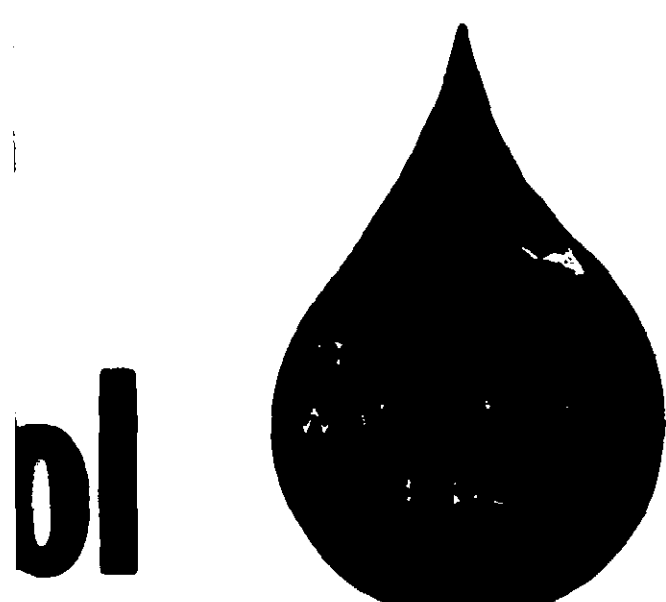

UTIKEM ALGAE CONTROL controls the growth of microscopic plants called algae which thrive in warm, sunlit pools. It is algae that turns the water green and produces odors that make swimming unpleasant. This condition is easily and quickly controlled with the use of UTIKEM ALGAE CONTROL. This liquid product is added to the pool at periodic intervals throughout the swimming season and its use will prevent algae from growing. One gallon is sufficient to treat 25,000 gallons of pool water initially. It is important to note that small amounts of UTIKEM ALGAE CONTROL added at regular intervals will do a better job for algae prevention control than large amounts added only where algae has become a nuisance. A chart is provided for the pool owner, so that the amount of UTIKEM ALGAE CONTROL to be added may be determined.

Use initial dose when filling the pool with fresh water. If pool has visible algae, the initial dose should be repeated after algae debris is removed from pool. A maintenance dose should be added every 3 to 5 days.

This product is toxic to fish. Treated effluent should not be discharged where it will drain into lakes, streams, ponds, or public water. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

In hot sunny weather more frequent additions of UTIKEM ALGAE CONTROL may be necessary.

To determine capacity of pool: square or rectangular/multiply width by length by average depth (in feet), multiply total by 7.5 to convert to gallons capacity.

Round/multiply the diameter by the diameter by average depth (in feet). Multiply total by 5.0 for gallons capacity.

CAUTION

Keep Out of Reach of Children. Causes eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

FIRST AID

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician.

Do not pre-mix with other pool chemicals. Add directly to pool. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
