

Use initial dose when filling the pool at beginning of swimming season. If visible algae is present after initial application, vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove algae debris. If visible algae are still present or should reappear, repeat treatment procedure as necessary. When pool is free of visible algae, proceed to use the recommended maintenance dose at 3-5 day intervals. During hot, sunny weather or heavy bathing loads, more frequent additions may be necessary.
