{This product controls algae growth in swimming pool water without causing foaming. This product is effective at both high and low pH levels. This product is compatible with chlorinating products and other chemicals used to treat swimming pools and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, DO NOT mix this product with concentrated dry or liquid chlorinating products.}

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This product is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools. For maximum effectiveness, pools containing heavy growth of algae must be cleaned prior to using this product.

This product is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools, and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. This product can be used in pools treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, DO NOT mix this product with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

INITIAL DOSE: For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add initially [for ½ gallon and larger containers]{20 to 37 fl. oz. of this product per 5,000 gallons} [for quart size and smaller] {10 to 18 fl. oz. of this product per 2,500 gallons} of water.

VISIBLE ALGAE: For pools having just visible algae growth, add an initial dose of [for ½ gallon and larger containers]{37 to 58 fl. oz. of this product per 5,000 gallons} [for quart size and smaller] {18 to 29 fl. oz. of this product per 2,500 gallons} of water and remove settled debris by cleaning.

WINTERIZING: This product will prevent growth of most algae during the off season winter months when pools are not in use. For pools which have been properly treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add [for ½ gallon and larger containers]{20 to 32 fl. oz. of this product per 5,000 gallons} [for quart size and smaller] {10 to 16 fl. oz. of this product per 2,500 gallons} of water. If at the end of the swimming season, pools have some visible algae growth, add [for ½ gallon and larger containers]{37 to 56 fl. oz. of this product per 5,000 gallons} [for quart size and smaller] {18 to 28 fl. oz. of this product per 2,500 gallons} of water. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of this product throughout the water the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. If pool is not covered, it may be necessary to repeat treatment one or more times during the season.

##### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
