**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND
DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

DANGER:

Corrosive. causes eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. May cause burns to broken skin. Protect skin and eyes when handling. Wash hands after handling.

**PRACTICAL TREATMENT
(FIRST AID):**

If swallowed feed gruel, cooked cereal or bread soaked in milk, followed by olive oil or cooking oil. In case of personal contact, remove excess material and flush skin or eyes with cold water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes get medical attention as soon as possible.

CHEMICAL HAZARDS:

Strong oxidizing agent. Do not use moist or damp utensils. Contaminator with moisture, dirt, organic matter, or other chemicals, or any other foreign matter, may start a chemical reaction with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases, and possible generation of fire.

**ENVIRONMENTAL
HAZARDS:**

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Keep out of lakes, streams, ponds, or other waters. Permits may be required for discharges containing this pesticide into public waters.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN ANY MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

WATER SHOULD BE CLEAN WITH NO VISIBLE ALGAE BEFORE USING UTIKEM WINTER-BUOY

1. Punch out holes on sides of WINTER BUOY DISPENSER
2. Insert WINTER BUOY DISPENSER in ring with holes toward bottom of pool
3. Place in pool as close to center as possible and in deepest part of pool. Secure with string or rope to make sure WINTER BUOY does not float to side of pool. Under no circumstances should the WINTER BUOY be permitted to float in water less than 3 1/2 feet deep.
4. Cover pool with suitable pool cover.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:

Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, well-ventilated area away from heat and open flame. In case of decomposition create container in open area if possible and flood with large amounts of water. Rinse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water before disposal. Do not discharge into trash or sewer.
