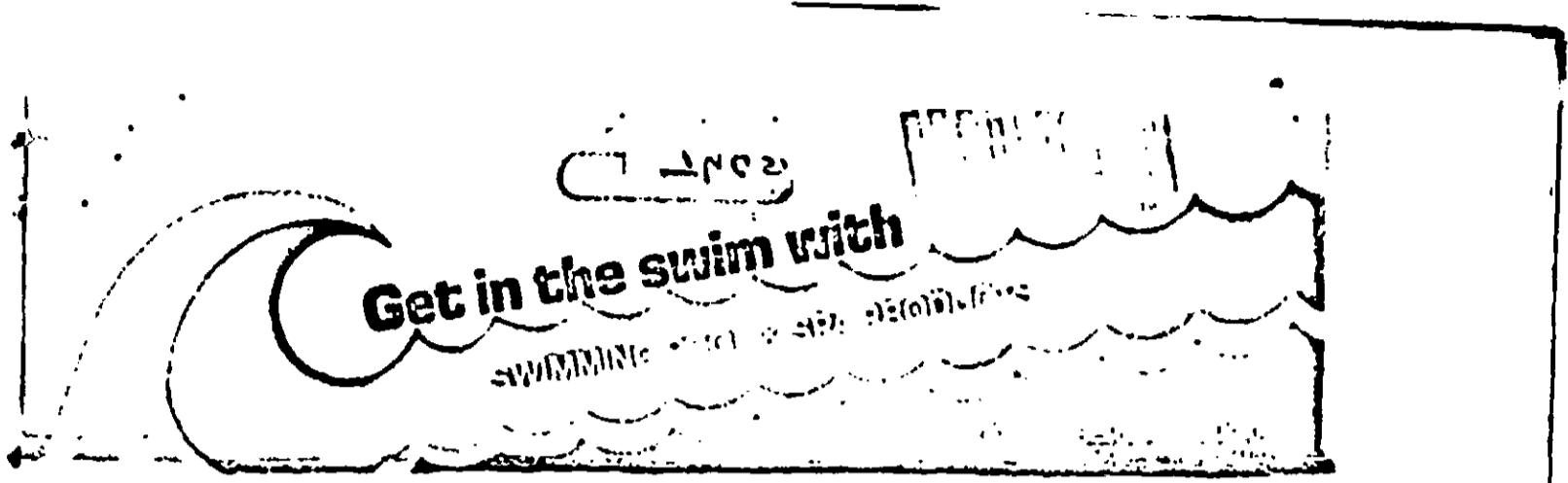

UTIKEM KIDDIE POOL SURFACE SANITIZER AND ALGAECIDE WHEN USED AS DIRECTED WILL CONTROL THE GROWTH OF CHLORELLA PYRENDOISA (GREEN) AND PHORMIDIUM INUNDATUM (BLUE-GREEN) SPECIES OF ALGAE.

UTIKEM KIDDIE POOL SURFACE SANITIZER AND ALGAECIDE controls the growth of microscopic plants called algae which thrive in warm, sunlit pools. It is algae that turns the water green and produces odors that make swimming unpleasant.

TREATMENT: For initial application in a clean and freshly filled, algae-free pool, use 1 packette (2 oz.) for every 200 gallons of water. If visible algae is present, use 2 packettes (4 oz.) for every 200 gallons of water and remove dead algae debris with pool vacuum, skimmer, etc. If visible algae is still present, repeat treatment until algae growth is visibly controlled.

200gal (6' dia x 12" deep)	1 packette (2oz)
450gal (8' dia x 15" deep)	2 packettes (4oz)

OVAL POOLS: Multiply largest diameter in feet x shortest diameter in feet x average depth in feet x 6.7. The result will be capacity of pool in gallons.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA is acceptable, provided that you:

1. For the Packette label:
 - a. In the first paragraph, add the sentence "surface must be cleaned prior to sanitizing" to precede the sentence "To sanitize pool walls...."
 - b. At the bottom of the rear panel replace the words "Directions and Information" with the words "Precautions and Directions for Use."
 - c. Add the sentence "Disposal, wrap empty packet and put in trash collection."
2. For the plastic package label:
 - a. The Precautionary Statements (right, rear panel) are inadequate. The "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" (Item 8a of "The label" enclosure) is lacking. We recommend that you use the "Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" statements made on your packet as below:

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING: Keep out of reach of children. Harmful if swallowed. Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Protect eyes and skin when handling. Avoid contamination of food.

PRACTICAL TREATMENT, (FIRST AID): If swallowed, promptly drink a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid a alcohol. - b. The correct "Environmental Hazards" caution is:

Environmental Hazards

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds or public waters unless in accordance with a NPDES permit. For guidance, contact your Regional Office of the Environmental Protection Agency.

- c. The "Storage and Disposal" statement should be replaced with the statement as given in paragraph 1(c) above.


2. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

After a preliminary review of your draft label for the above-referenced product, we have determined that this product is subject to Child-Resistant Packaging regulations (effective March 9, 1981). Refer to 40 CFR 162.16 "Pesticides Requiring Special Packaging" and the Federal Register Vol. 46, No. 41, Tuesday, March 3, 1981 pp. 15104-15109 "Clarification of Policy Issues on Special Packaging" for guidance and proper submission requirements.
