This liquid product is added to the pool at periodic intervals throughout the swimming season and its use will prevent algae from growing. It is important to note that small amounts of Utikem Alage Destroyer added at regular intervals will do a better job for algae prevention control than large amounts added only where algae has become a nuisance. START-UP: Add to a freshly filled, algae free pool at the rate of 1 gallon for every 12,500 gallons of water. Add to water along pool edges. If algae growth is not controlled, repeat above treatment until algae growth is visibly controlled. Remove dead algae and debris with pool vacuum, skimmer, etc.

For best results with this product, use your pool water filter (if available) according to the directions of the filter manufacturer.

REGULAR CARE: After start-up, use 1 quart every 5 to 7 days for every 12,500 gallons of water. When weather is hot or many people are using the pool, it may be necessary to use 1 quart every 5 days as necessary.
