The amendment referred to above, submitted in conjunction with registration under FIFRA to revise the label and add winterization instructions is acceptable subject to the following comments.

- 1) In order to add clarity to the "Directions for Use" section of the label, revise "This liquid product is added to the pool at periodic intervals throughout the swimming season and its use will prevent algae growth from growing." by deleting the phrase "...from growing."
- 2) Revise the "Storage and Disposal" section of the label such that the statement "Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal." immediately follows the heading "Storage and Disposal" as illustrated below:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Keep container closed when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from reactive materials. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse container and put in trash.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Utikem Algae Destroyer Algaecide, when used as directed, will kill and prevent development of chlorella pyrencidosa (green) and phormidium inundatum (blue-green algae). Utikem Algae Destroyer Algaecide controls the growth of microscopic plants called algae which thrive in warm, sunlit pools. It is algae that turns the water green and produces cdors that make swimming unpleasant. This condition is controlled with the use of Utikem Algae Destroyer Algaecide. This liquid product is added to the pool at periodic intervals throughout the swimming season and its use will prevent algae growth from growing. It is important to note that small amounts of Utikem Algae Destroyer Algaecide added at regular intervals will do a better job for algae prevention control than large amounts added only when algae becomes a nuisance. Utikem Algae Destroyer Algaecide is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals, but should not be mixed with soap or other cleaners, or pre-mixed with other water treating chemicals.

START-UP: Add to a freshly filled, algae free pool at the rate of 1 gallon for every 12,500 gallons of water. Add to water along pool edges. If visible algae is present, use 1 gallon for every 6,250 gallons of water. Add to water along pool edges. If algae growth is not controlled, repeat above treatment until algae growth is visibly controlled. Remove dead algae and debris with pool vacuum, skimmer etc.

For best results, pool should be cleaned and filled with fresh algae-free water before use. Maintain the pH in the range of 7.2 to 7.6. After the addition of Algae Destroyer, run filter for 2 hours to allow for circulation. After adding Algae Destroyer to the pool water, wait approximately 1/2 hour before using pool.

REGULAR CARE: After start-up, use 1 quart (which equals 32 fl. oz.) every 5 to 7 days for every 12,500 gallons of water. When weather is hot or many people are using the pool, it may be necessary to use 1 quart every 5 days as necessary. Refer to the use chart to determine the amount needed to correctly treat pool water.

WINTERIZING: Remove leaves and other debris from pool water. Adjust pH to 7.2 to 7.6. While the filter pump is running, add 1 gallon of Algae Destroyer per 12,500 gallons of pool water. After 2 hours, shut off pump, disconnect filters, chlorinators, etc. Cover pool to keep out airborne matter. In the Spring, reconnect equipment and add chemicals as normally required.
