

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:**

**IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN ANY MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.**

**ONE OUNCE OF UTIKEM CHLORINATING GRANULES WILL PROVIDE 0.5 p.p.m. OF AVAILABLE CHLORINE IN 10,000 GALLONS OF WATER.**

**START UP:**

1. Adjust pH of pool water to 7.2 - 7.6 range with UTIKEM pH Control Chemicals. Use a suitable UTIKEM Test Kit as a guide.
2. To a clean pool which is free of visible algae, add 10 oz. of UTIKEM CHLORINATING GRANULES for every 10,000 gallons of water.
3. Wait ½ hour and test water for chlorine level using a UTIKEM Test Kit.
4. If the chlorine level is below 0.6-1.0 p.p.m., add an additional ½ oz. of UTIKEM CHLORINATING GRANULES for every 10,000 gallons of water for every 0.2 p.p.m. that chlorine level is to be raised.

**REGULAR CARE:**

1. After start up add 6-8 oz. of UTIKEM CHLORINATING GRANULES for every 10,000 gallons of water daily, or as needed, as determined by your UTIKEM Test Kit.
2. Check pool water daily with your UTIKEM Test Kit and maintain a chlorine level of 0.6 - 1.0 p.p.m. and a pH of 7.2 - 7.6.
3. During extremely hot weather and/or heavy bathing loads, additional treatment may be required.
4. For pool water previously treated with UTIKEM CHLORINE STABILIZER AND WATER CONDITIONER (Cyanuric Acid), maintain a chlorine level of 1.0 - 1.5 p.p.m. Use 3 oz. of UTIKEM CHLORINATING GRANULES for every 10,000 gallons of water every other day or as needed to maintain a chlorine level of 1.0-1.5 p.p.m.

#### SUPER CHLORINATION:

1. If visible algae is present, use 1 ounce of UTIKEM CHLORINATING GRANULES for every 500 gallons of pool water. This treatment should be given at night or when the pool is not in use. Turn the filter to "off".
2. After approximately 6-8 hours, start the filter and vacuum & scrub dead algae from pool bottom and walls.
3. Do not use the pool until the chlorine level has dropped to 3.0 p.p.m. or less as determined by your UTIKEM Test Kit.
4. If visible growth of algae should occur again, repeat treatment as indicated.

#### USEFUL POOL FACTS:

##### ESTIMATING POOL CAPACITY:

RECTANGULAR & SQUARE POOLS: Multiply length in feet x width in feet x average depth in feet x 7.5. The result will be capacity of pool in gallons.

ROUND POOLS: Multiply diameter in feet x diameter in feet x average depth in feet x 5.9. The result will be capacity of pool in gallons.

OVAL POOLS: Multiply longest diameter in feet x shortest diameter in feet x average depth in feet x 5.9. The result will be capacity of pool in gallons.
