

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Reentry into treated swimming pools/spas is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm.

Tarry Long-Lasting Chlorinating 1/2 oz. Tablets are to be used as a disinfectant and algae control in pool water. They are long-lasting and are intended to slowly meter chlorine into pool water. Tarry Long-Lasting Chlorinating 1/2 oz. Tablets are intended for use in a tablet dispenser, in-line chlorinator, in-line feeder or other similar dispenser. In order to receive its maximum effect, use as follows:

1. Superchlorinate the pool water with a fast acting shock treatment or other chlorinating product, following label directions for that product. Do not enter pool until the chlorine residual drops to 2.0 ppm (parts per million).
2. Using Coastal Chlorine Stabilizer, adjust the cyanuric acid level in pool water to 35 ppm, following label directions.
3. Adjust the pH to the ideal range of 7.2 to 7.6 using Coastal pH Plus if the pH is below 7.2 or Coastal pH Minus if the pH is above 7.6.
4. Suggested dosage is fourteen (14) Tarry Long-Lasting Chlorinating 1/2 oz. Tablets per 9,800 gallons of pool water per week. Add tablets to a floating dispenser, in-line feeder or similar as needed as determined by a chlorine test kit to maintain a 1.0 to 1.5 ppm (parts per million) residual chlorine. Check water for chlorine content at regular intervals. This dosage may vary due to unusual conditions, such as heavy bather loads, heavy rains or high temperatures. During these conditions, water should be checked every 2 hours. Maintain a pH level of 7.2 to 7.6 for best results.

Fourteen (14) Blue Seal Slow-Tabs weigh approximately 7 oz. (198 grams) and WILL LAST APPROXIMATELY ONE WEEK DEPENDING ON TEMPERATURE, BATHER LOAD AND AMOUNT OF WATER FLOW. One Tarry Long-Lasting Chlorinating 1/2 oz. Tablet weighs approximately 1/2 oz. (14 grams). Tabs should never be thrown directly into pool as they may cause spotting or bleaching. Not recommended for splashers or wader pools.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
