The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under section of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with comments.

**Proposed Amendment:**

- revised First Aid statement PR Notice 2001-1
- storage and disposal PER PR Notice 2001-6

**General Comments:**

1. Remove the "Keep Out Of Reach of Children" statement from the precautionary statement. The statement is only required on the front panel, immediately below the ingredient statement.

2. The precautionary statement must be revised to read as follow:

Harmful if Swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Non-Foaming Algaeicide for Spas 'N Hot Tubs is used to control the growth of algae in exterior hot tubs and spas. For maximum effectiveness, spas and hot tubs containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using Non-Foaming Algaeicide for Spas 'N Hot Tubs.

Spas or hot tubs having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 5 oz. to 7½ fluid ounces Non-Foaming Algaeicide per 500 gallons of water. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled spa or hot tub, add initially 3½ to 5 fluid ounces of Non-Foaming Algaeicide per 500 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 1 to 2½ fluid ounces of Non-Foaming Algaeicide should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Non-Foaming Algaeicide for Spas 'N Hot Tubs is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat spas and hot tubs and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Non-Foaming Algaeicide can be used in spas and hot tubs treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix Non-Foaming Algaeicide with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.

##### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

##### FIRST AID
