Dear Ms. Schaub:

The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with conditions.

Proposed Amendment

- Adding optional Winterization Directions

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1.) Add the heading, "Swimming Pool Winterizing Directions," to appear above "Dosage Rates" on page 2.

2.) The "Initial Pool Start-Up" instructions on page 2 must be brought into compliance with PR Notice 2000-5, Mandatory Labeling, by deleting the term, should, and stating "must."

3.) Based on the records on file for acute toxicology, this product is classified as category III for acute oral and dermal and category IV for inhalation and eye irritation. Therefore, you must revise the "Precautionary Statements" to state:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

4) You must reorganize the "First Aid" Statements to be in the order of most severe routes of exposure, demonstrated by the toxicity classification: IF Swallowed, If on Skin or Clothing, If in Eyes, and If Inhaled.


5) Delete the "Note to Physician" because this product's acute toxicology profile does not warrant this language.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

{Spa Directions}

[Non-Foaming Algaecide for Spas 'N Hot Tubs is used to control the growth of algae in exterior hot tubs and spas.

BEFORE YOU BEGIN: Make sure hot tub Make sure hot tub equipment is working properly including pump, filter and heater. Allow filter to run for at least an hour after adding this product. Check water pH (acidity/alkalinity/balance) with a test kit. Desired range is between 7.2-7.6. If necessary, adjust pH by adding pH Minus or pH Plus to raise pH. Add this product directly into hot tub/spa by pouring around its perimeter.

INITIAL APPLICATION: For maximum effectiveness, hot tubs/spa with heavy algae growth must be pre-cleaned before using this product. **VISIBLE ALGAE:** Vacuum algae debris. Add 2 ½ oz. to 3 ¾ fl. oz. of this product per 250 gallons of water around perimeter of hot tub/spa. Remove dead algae after 24 hours. If algae is still visible, repeat dosage until hot tub/spa is free of algae. Once algae is under control, clean filter and return to normal operation.

NO VISIBLE ALGAE: (Freshly Cleaned and Filled Spa or Hot Tub): Add 1 ¾ to 2 ½ fl. oz. of this product per 250 gallons of water around the perimeter of hot tub/spa/

MAINTENANCE APPLICATION: Add ½ to 1 ¼ fl. oz. of this product per 250 gallons of water every 5 to 7 days. Add this product directly to hot tub by pouring around its perimeter. Add more frequently if there is prolonged rainfall or heavy bathing load.

Do not allow bathers into hot tub/spa for at least 15 minutes after this product has been applied. Non-Foaming Algaecide for Spas 'N Hot Tubs is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat spas and hot tubs and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Non-Foaming Algaecide can be used in spas and hot tubs treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix Non-Foaming Algaecide with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.]

{Winter Directions for Swimming Pools}

[**DOSAGE RATES:** Solid Covered Pools: Apply 1 quart of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water. Mesh Covered or Uncovered Pools: Apply 1 quart per 5,000 gallons of pool water.

APPLICATION: Shake the container well and pour the proper amount of this product around the entire pool perimeter. Continue circulation of pool water for 6 hours to ensure proper distribution of this product.

INITIAL POOL START-UP: In the Spring, winterized pools ~~should~~ be cleaned and vacuumed. Start your algae-free swimming season by using this product as part of your regular swimming season maintenance program.

IMPORTANT NOTE: This product is compatible with other pool treatment chemicals. Compatible with all sanitizers including bromine, chlorine, salt water, ozone and minerals.
