# DANGER FIRST AID

Algon 60 Algaecide controls algae growth in swimming pool water without causing foaming. This product is effective at both high and low pH levels. Algon 60 Algaecide is compatible with chlorinating products and other chemicals used to treat swimming pools and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, DO NOT mix this product with concentrated dry or liquid chlorinating products.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Algon 60 Algaecide is used to control the growth of many algae types, including green, black and mustard algae. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool, add an initial dose of 6 to 12 fl. oz. Algon 60 Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. For maximum effectiveness, heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to use of Algon 60 Algaecide. Pools containing just visible algae growth should receive an initial dose of 12 to 18 fl. oz. of Algon 60 Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. After 24 hours, vacuum pool to remove algae debris. On a regular basis, (every 5 to 7 days), use a maintenance dose of 2 to 4 fl. oz. of Algon 60 Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. During, hot sunny weather, more frequent additions may be necessary.

Algon 60 Algaecide will prevent the growth of most algae during the off season, when the pool is not in use. For pools which have been properly treated during the swimming season, and are free of visible algae, add 6 to 10 fl. oz. of Algon 60 Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. If at the end of the season, the pool has some visible algae growth, add 12 to 18 fl. oz. of Algon 60 Algaecide per 10,000 gallons of water. For best results, circulate the pool water, prior to covering the pool for the winter.
