

CHEMICAL PROPERTIES

When Coastal Cocnetrate 50 Algaecide 50 is used as directed, it will kill Chlorella pyrenoidosa, (green algae), Phormidium inundatum (black algae), Phormidium retzii, Lyngba versicolor (blue green algae) and other visible swimming pool algae.

NOTE: Kill, control and/or destroy. Refer to initial dose. To supress or inhibit growth: Refer to maintenance dose. Coastal Concentrate 50 Algaecide 50 is compatible with most commonly used swimming pool chemicals but should not be mixed with soap or other cleaners or premixed with other water treating chemicals. Coastal Concentrate 50 Algaecide 50 works best when added by itself directly to swimming pool water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Initial dose is used at the beginning of the swimming season when filling the pool. Visible algae growth will require vacuuming to remove algae debris. Before adding this product, ensure that all pool equipment is working properly. Backwash the filter system according to the manufacturer's directions. Adjust the pH to between 7.2 and 7.6. Adjust chlorine residual to 1-3 ppm. If the pool has visible algae growth, the initial dose should be repeated within 48 hours after the killed algae are removed from the pool. Maintenance dose should be added at least once every 7 days. Add Coastal Concentrate 50 Algaecide 50 to the pool water at various points or through the filter. Allow water to circulate 2 hours after the addition of Coastal Concentrate 50 Algaecide 50. During this period, swimmers are not allowed to enter the water. If high temperatures prevail or pool has unusually heavy use, add maintenance dose more frequently.
