**LABELING:** (Statements are based on review of referenced acute toxicity data)

1. The signal word is "DANGER"
2. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read:

**CORROSIVE:** Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if absorbed through skin. May be fatal if inhaled. Do not breathe dust or spray mists. Irritating to nose and throat. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, protective clothing and rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

3. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read:

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT.**

**IF SWALLOWED:** Drink promptly large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician or poison control center immediately.

**IF IN EYES:** Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Reentry into treated swimming pools/baths is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm.

Terry Long-Lasting Chlorinating 7 oz. Sticks are to be used as a disinfectant and algae control in pool water. They are long-lasting and are intended to slowly meter chlorine into pool water. Terry Long-Lasting Chlorinating 7 oz. Sticks are intended for use in a tablet dispenser, in-line chlorinator, in-line feeder or other similar dispensers. In order to receive its maximum effect, use as follows:

1. Superchlorinate the pool water with either Coastal's Iso Chlor Powder, IsoChlorinating Granules or Blast Sheet Treatment, following label directions for that product. Do not enter pool until the chlorine residual drops to 2.0 ppm (parts per million).
2. Using Chlorine Stabilizer, adjust the cyanuric acid level in pool water to 30 ppm, following label directions.
3. Adjust the pH to the ideal range of 7.2 to 7.6 with Coastal pH Plus if the pH is below 7.2, or pH Minus if the pH is above 7.6.
4. Suggested dosage is one Terry Long-Lasting Chlorinating 7 oz. Stick per 10,000 gallons of pool water per week. Add sticks to a feeding dispenser, in-line feeder, or similar and adjust the chlorine residual to 1.0 to 1.5 ppm (parts per million). Check water for chlorine content at regular intervals using a reliable test kit.

This dosage may vary, due to unusual conditions such as heavy bather loads, heavy rains or high temperatures. If these conditions exist, water should be checked every 2 hours. Maintain a pH of 7.2 to 7.6 for best results. One stick weighs approximately 7 oz. (198 grams) and WILL LAST APPROXIMATELY ONE WEEK DEPENDING ON TEMPERATURE, BATHER LOAD AND AMOUNT OF WATER FLOW.

Sticks should never be thrown directly into pool as they may cause spotting or bleaching. Not recommended for water or splasher pools.
