ISOCYANURATE RED ATTACHMENT A

LABELING: (Statements are based on review of referenced acute toxicity data)

1. The signal word is "DANGER"
2. Revise the Precautionary Statements to read:

CORROSIVE: Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if absorbed through skin. May be fatal if inhaled. Do not breathe dust or spray mists. Irritating to nose and throat. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield, protective clothing and rubber gloves when handling this product. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

3. Revise the Statement of Practical Treatment to read:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT.

IF SWALLOWED: Drink promptly large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Call a physician or poison control center immediately.

IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Reentry into treated swimming pools/spas is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm.

Using a reliable test kit, adjust the pH of the pool water, if necessary, to the pH range of 7.2 to 7.6. If the pH is below 7.2, add pH Increaser. If the pH is above 7.6, add pH Minus. Tarry Long-Lasting Individualized Chlorinating 8 oz. Tablet are intended for use in a tablet dispenser, automatic in-line chlorinator, or other similar dispensers or in-line feeders. Adjust the chlorine dispensing rate of the dispenser or feeder to provide a chlorine residual of 1.0 to 1.5 ppm (parts per million). A suggested dosage is one tablet (8 oz.) per 11,500 gallons of water per week. This dosage may vary due to unusual conditions such as heavy bather load, wind, heavy rains or high temperatures. If those conditions exist, frequent use of a test kit is recommended. Do not add these sticks directly to pool or mix with any other chemicals.
