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

Reentry into treated swimming pools/spas is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm.

Once-A-Week Tarry Long-Lasting Individualized Chlorinating 8 oz. Tablets are to be used as a disinfectant and algae control in pool water. They are long-lasting and are intended to slowly meter chlorine into pool water. Once-A-Week Tarry Long-Lasting Individualized Chlorinating 8 oz. Tablets are intended for use in a tablet dispenser, in-line chlorinator, inline feeder or other similar dispenser. In order to receive its maximum effect, use as follows:

- 1. Superchlorinate the pool water with fast acting Coastal Blast Shock Treatment or other chlorinating product, following label directions for that product. Do not enter pool until the chlorine residual drops to 2.0 ppm (parts per million),
- Using Coastal Chlorine Stabilizer, adjust the cvanuric acid level in pool water to 35 ppm, following label directions.
- 3. Adjust the pH to the ideal range of 7.2 to 7.6 using Coastal pH Plus If the pH is below 7.2 or Coastal pH Minus if the pH is above 7.6.


