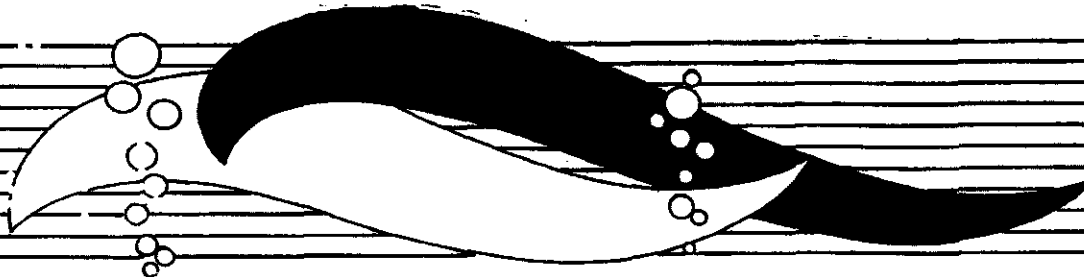

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool dry well ventilated area away from heat and open flame.

IF PARTLY FILLED: Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Reentry into treated swimming pools/spas is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm.

Coastal Winter Chlor Long-Lasting Chlorinating Tablets are to be used to help control, by disinfectant and algaestatic action, swim pool odors and algae during the winter months. Each tablet weighs 5-1/3 oz., and each 3-tab basket of Winter Chlor Long-Lasting Chlorinating Tablets treats up to 22,000 gallons of water. They are intended to slowly meter chlorine into pool water. In order to obtain its maximum effect, use as follows:

1. Remove all debris from pool by skimming surface, running filter and vacuuming foreign particles from bottom of pool.
2. Superchlorinate with Coastal Blast One Shot Shock Treatment or Iso Chlor Chlorinating Powder. Continue running filter pump. When the free chlorine residual reduces to 1 to 3 ppm (parts per million), add Coastal Winterizer while walking around the edge of the pool. Then remove the 3-tab basket(s) of Winter Chlor Long-Lasting Chlorinating Tablets from plastic bags, and drop basket(s) into water toward center of the pool.
3. Drain any water from filter and pool piping to prevent freezing. Disconnect filters, pipes, chlorinators, lights, etc.
4. Cover the pool with a winter pool cover.
