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

Coastal Winter Chlor Long-Lasting Chlor nating Tablets are to be used to help control, by disinfectant and algaestatic action, swim pool odors and algae during the winter months. Each tablet weighs 5-1/3 oz., and each 3-tab basket of Winter Chlor Long-Lasting Chlorinating Tablets treats up to 22,000 gallons of water. They are intended to slowly meter chlorine into pool water. In order to obtain its maximum effect, use as follows:

- 1. Remove all debris from pool by skimming surface, running filter and vacuuming foreign particles from bottom of pool.
- 2. Superchlorinate with Coastal Blas. One Shot Shock Treatment or Iso Clor Chlorinating Powder. Continue running filter pump. When the free chlorine residual reduces to 1 to 3 ppm (parts per million), add Coastal Winterizer while walking around the edge of the pool. Then remove the 3-tab basket(s) of Winter Chlor Long-Lasting Chlorinating Tablets from plastic bags, and drop basket(s) into water toward center of the pool.
