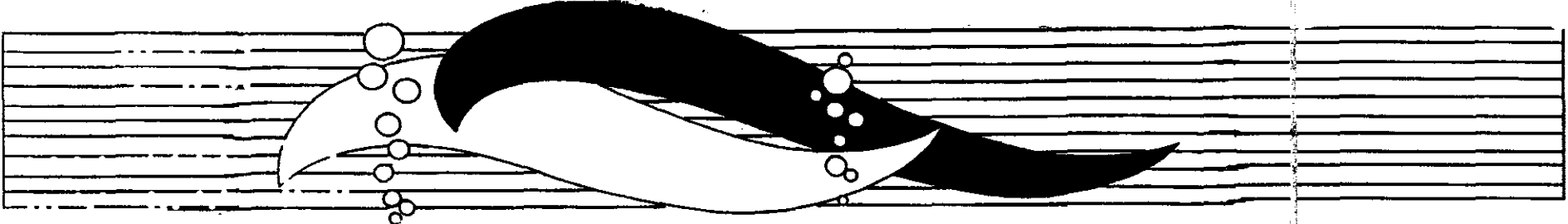

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Reentry into treated swimming pools/spas is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm.

Recommended for hot tubs and spas operating at temperatures 90°F to 105°F. Coastal Hot Tubs and Spas Long-Lasting 1/2 oz. Chlorinating Tablets are to be used as a disinfectant and algae control. Each disposable floating dispenser contains two 1/2 oz. tablets intended to slowly meter chlorine into water.

**START-UP:** When starting up a reopened or freshly filled hot tub or spa, make sure that the filtration system is clean and operating properly. Using a Poolchem test kit, check the pH of the water and adjust, if necessary, using pH Plus or pH Minus, following label directions. Adjust the pH to the range of 7.2 to 7.8. Then chlorinate the water with Coastal Hot Tubs and Spas Stabilized Chlorinating Concentrated Granules, while the circulating system is operating and the aeration is shut off.

**DAILY:** Using a Poolchem test kit as a daily guide, maintain the free chlorine residual of the water at 1.0 to 1.5 ppm (parts per million). If the reading obtained is below 1.0 ppm, add an additional floating dispenser of chlorinated tablets. For best results, maintain a pH of 7.2 to 7.8. If below 7.2, add Coastal pH Plus, or if above 7.8, add pH Minus, following label directions. Superchlorinate hot tub and spa water periodically with Coastal Hot Tubs and Spas Stabilized Chlorinating Concentrated Granules. High bather loads will require more frequent superchlorination to ensure, clean, clear, healthy water.
