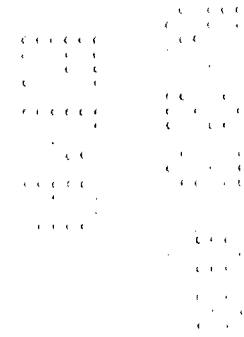
Dear Ms. Mitchell:

ONE TABLET TREATS UP TO 5,000 GALLONS

Tab-A-Day Daily Chlorinating Tablets provide effective control of bacteria and algae growth in pool water. DO NOT add this product directly to pool water or to continuous tablet chlorinating devices. Tab-A-Day Daily Chlorinating Tablets are intended for addition to the pool skimmer or into a floating dispenser. Do not mix this product with any other chemical.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Reentry into treated swimming pools/spas is prohibited above levels of 3.0 ppm.

START-UP: When starting up a reopened or freshly filled swimming pool, make sure that the filtration system is clean and operating properly. Then adjust and maintain the pH in the range of 7.2 to 7.6. Use Coastal pH Plus or pH Minus as indicated by a PoolChem Test Kit. Then superchlorinate with Blast One Shot Shock Treatment or Shock X-tra to establish a free chlorine residual of 1.0 to 1.5 ppm (parts per million). If your pool has not been stabilized previously, add Coastal Chlorine Stabilizer (cyanuric acid) until 30 ppm is obtained following label directions.

DAILY: Add Tab-A-Day Daily Chlorinating Tablets to the pool skimmer or floating dispenser as necessary to maintain a 1.0 to 1.5 ppm chlorine residual. A suggested dosage is one Tab-A-Day tablet (approx. 1 oz.) per 5,000 gallons of water daily. This dosage may vary due to unusual conditions such as heavy bather loads, wind, heavy rains and high temperatures. Therefore, frequent use of a PoolChem Test Kit is recommended as a guide to maintain the pH at 7.2 to 7.6 and the chlorine residual at 1.0 to 1.5 ppm.

FIRST AID
