BACTERIOSTATIC RUG SHAMPOO CONCENTRATE

CAUTION: Keep out of reach of children. See other cautions on side panel.

Active ingredients:

Sodium Lauryl Sulfate.....	9.0%
Isopropanol.....	5.0%
5-Chloro-2-(2,4-dichlorophenoxy) phenol.....	0.5%
2,2' Methylene bis (3,4,6-trichloro phenol).....	0.2%
Essential oils.....	0.4%
Tetrasodium Ethylene Diamine Tetraacetate.....	0.2%

Inert ingredients:

Water, sodium N-lauroyl sarcosinate, optical brighteners.....	84.7%
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NET CONTENTS 5 GALLONS

DIRECTIONS: Vacuum carpet to remove dust and loose soil. Dilute with water at a ratio of 1:16, or 3 oz. of BAC-TEX in a gallon of water. Fill solution tank with diluted solution. Shampoo with circular, overlapping strokes without soaking the carpet. When dry, vacuum thoroughly.

Always test a small, hidden portion of the rug with a white cloth dampened in a 1:16 dilution of BAC-TEX for color fastness. Use only on color-fast carpet.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.
