RESIDUAL ACTION

One spraying of the Shoo-Fly HORNET Jet-Bomb lasts for weeks. When used as directed this bomb leaves an invisible film that continues to kill hornets, wasps, earwigs, bees, flies, ants, mosquitoes, spiders and aids in the prevention of maggots in garbage pails.

DIRECTIONS

TO OPERATE: Remove protective cap. Point nozzle toward area to be sprayed and press valve lightly for a mist spray; and press down all the way for a long-distance stream spray. The special nozzle will project a stream 25 feet. Spray surfaces to point of run-off. Treated surfaces have a residual killing action for two to four weeks against insects. If reinfestations occur, due to migrations — or removal of the insecticidal film by water or wear, repeat treatment.

FOR LONG-RANGE DISTANCE BOMBING (up to 25 feet)

HORNETS, WASPS, BEES: Here is a good method to control these insects when they become a menace. Look for the holes where they enter, or surfaces where they congregate — and spray thoroughly. Be sure to depress nozzle all the way down, and move back as far as possible. Those insects hit directly by the spray will fall to the ground very shortly. Since the spray is residual, insects coming in contact with the sprayed surfaces, will die soon after. Usually, the treated areas are free of hornets 24 hours after spraying.

FOR SHORT-RANGE MIST-BOMBING (Use only as Mist Spray 12" to 18" from surface.)

EARWIGS: Use regular mist spray. Hold container 12 to 18" from surface to be sprayed. Spray to the point of run-off, door-sills, windowsills, lawn furniture, clothes posts, junction between foundation and house, and other areas where earwigs tend to congregate.

SPIDERS: Spray spiders and their immediate vicinity thoroughly.

MAGGOTS: To aid in keeping garbage cans free of flies and maggots, spray inside and outside frequently.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES: Apply only as a residual spray to screens and surfaces where insects alight.

ANTS: Spray ant hills, around doors and windows and wherever ants enter the house. Repeat as required.

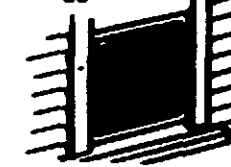

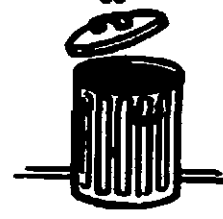

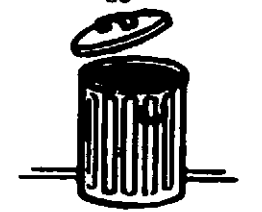
