The proposed amendment to the registration of the product cited above under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act removing the active ingredient, MGK R-11 and increasing the amount of active ingredient, MGK Repellent 326 is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. A stamped copy of the draft label is enclosed for your records.

- 1) Add the statement "Don't puncture or incinerate" to the disposal statement.
- 2) Change "Flammable" to "Extremely Flammable" in the physical and chemical hazards section. In lieu of this, submit the flashpoint of the product with the propellant.
- 3) A 1 year storage stability study must be submitted. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredient at time zero and during a year of storage. The storage must be under warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity using containers similar to those which will be used in the trade. This data must be submitted within 15 months of the date of this notice.

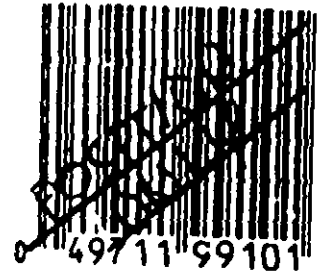
STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
