HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or inhaled through skin. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water. Wash with soap and water after use. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. Avoid contamination of food or feedstuffs. Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, food storage or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be cleaned during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Do not apply this water based product to conduits, motor housings, junction and switch boxes, or other electrical equipment because of possible shock and fire. Do not use on surfaces that may be damaged by water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

For Household Use and in Non-Food Areas of Industrial Buildings, Schools, Warehouses, Office Buildings, Theaters, Garages, Hotels, Motels, Kitchens, Kiosks, Common Household Pests: Cockroaches, Houseflies, Mosquitoes and others listed on back panel.

FOR SPACE SPRAY

To Kill Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Wasps. Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes, after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Before spraying cover exposed food and utensils.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches and Crickets. Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames and trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils, and Saw-toothed Grain Beetles. Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of these insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Centipedes, Firebrats, Silverfish, Sowbugs and Spiders. Contact as many insects as possible with spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas. Treat and destroy pets and bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of around households, windows and door frames, wall cracks and other areas of nests. Repeat as necessary. DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS. Dog bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated areas.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE

To Kill Ants, Brown Dog Ticks, Carpet Beetles, Cockroaches, Crickets, Fleas, Silverfish, Sowbugs and Spiders. Apply spray in short bursts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used to penetrate between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading into and from spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide. Avoid contact with food or food processing surfaces.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not store at temperatures over 130°F.

DISPOSAL: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Wash with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If effects occur, call a physician.
