DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. Point valve away from face and press button. Hold can at least 3 feet from surfaces which may stain and 18 inches from plants.

FOR CONTROL OF PESTS AROUND THE HOME. Flying insects (Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats and Moths): Direct spray at insects using short bursts (1-2 seconds) or treat unoccupied areas as follows: Close doors and windows. With a sweeping motion, direct spray upward to all parts of the room (8 to 10 seconds per 1000 cubic feet). Keep room closed for 15 minutes and ventilate before reoccupying. Do not remain in treated areas.

CRAWLING PESTS. (Ants, Boxelder Bugs, Crickets, Earwigs and Sowbugs): Spray into cracks or woodwork, walls, floors and other hiding and breeding places. Direct spray to contact pests when possible. Spray ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames.

WASPS, HORNETS AND YELLOW JACKETS. Direct spray at these insects using short bursts. Spray thoroughly into nests, hiding and breeding places when insects have settled at night. When nesting in ornamentals, trees and shrubs, Rhododendrons, Yews, Laurels, etc., Fog preferably in evening when air is still.

FOR CONTROL OF PESTS ON ORNAMENTAL PLANTS. Spray plants with a slow sweeping motion so that mist drifts into plants. Use caution on new growth and tender foliage. Repeat as necessary. When using outdoors spray when air is still. For control of beetles, aphids, adult white flies, Japanese Beetles, two spotted spider mites on outdoor plants (roses, rose of Sharon, azalea, chrysanthemum, euonymus, ivy marigold, petunia, snap dragon and zinnia) and on ornamental house and greenhouse plants (Aralia, chrysanthemum, cineraria, diffenbachia, fuscia, gloxinia, ivy, marigold, petunia, rose and snap dragon).

TREES AND SHRUBS. GYPSY MOTHS, TENT CATERPILLARS also Canker Worms, Garden Webworm, Aphids, Spider Mites and Adult White Flies on ornamental crabapples, cherries and plum trees, spray as above. Do not spray trees bearing fruit.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Avoid breathing of vapor and skin contact. Avoid contact with eyes. In case of contact flush with water.

Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before reuse. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation.
