The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the Permethrin, Tetramethrin and Piperonyl Butoxide REDs, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is **not** yet being reregistered under section 4(g) of FIFRA.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any previously dated CSFs are superseded.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to fish and other aquatic life. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas. To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area.

USE RESTRICTIONS

- Apply this product only as specified on label
- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift.

- For OUTDOOR USE ONLY. DO NOT USE INDOORS.
- Do not enter or allow adults, children or pets to enter treated area until sprays have dried.
- Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs
- Do not use this product directly on domestic (companion) animals(dogs, cats, puppies, or kittens)
- Do not make applications during rain.
- Do not use in food/feed areas. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. Serving areas are areas where food is served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held. Do not apply when food is present. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered or removed.
- When used in dairy barns or facilities: Close milk bulk tank lids to prevent contamination from spray and from dead or falling insects. Remove or cover milking utensils before application. Wash teats of animals before milking.

- All outdoor applications, if permitted elsewhere on this label, must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only, except for the following permitted used, if allowed elsewhere on this label: (1) Applications to soil or vegetation, as listed on this label, around structures; (2) Applications to lawns, turf, and other vegetation, as listed on this label; (3) Applications to the side of a building, up to a maximum height of 3 feet above grade; (4) Applications to underside of eaves, soffits, doors, or windows permanently protected from rainfall by a covering, overhang, awning, or other structure; (5) Applications around potential pest entry points into buildings, when limited to a surface band to exceed one inch in width and/or (6) Applications made through the use of a coarse, low pressure spray to only those portions of surfaces, that are directly above bare soil, lawn, turf, mulch or other vegetation, as listed on this label, and not over an impervious surface, drainage or other condition that could result in runoff into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters, or surface waters, in order to control occasional invaders or aggregating pests present at the time of application.
- Application of this product is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to storm sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow this product to enter any drain during or after application.
- This product is not for use in outdoor residential misting systems (indoor or outdoor), metered release misting systems, or indoor commercial animal premise automatic misting systems.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE

TO OPERATE THE CAN: Remove protective cap. Point nozzle toward area to be sprayed and press down all the way for a long-distance spray up to 20 feet.

To Kill: Hornets, wasps, yellow jackets, under eaves, screens, patios, window frames, cracks or holes in crevices or wherever insects are found, spray one to two seconds or until surfaces are moist but not to the point of run off. To prevent entrance of insects to house, spray around the points where insects enter such as outside plumbing, faucets, screens and surfaces etc. and cracks or crevices in foundation as well as along sills and ledges. Apply only as a residual spray where insects alight. Used as directed: one spraying of Shoofly Hornet Jet Bomb leaves an invisible film that kills up to 4 weeks.

OUTDOOR USE ONLY: For best results, spray in early morning or late evening when insect activity is minimal. Stand a safe distance from nest with wind at your back. Spray until nest is thoroughly saturated to kill the entire nest population. **Residual Action** will kill wasps and hornets returning to the nest. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

Do not spray vegetation directly to prevent damage to foliage. If spray accidentally contacts foliage, immediately wash with water. This product may discolor exterior surfaces of building, structures and painted surfaces and may cause staining (darkening) of asphalt surfaces and shingles. Test product in an inconspicuous area before applying.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

<u>Pesticide storage</u>: Do not store near heat or open flame. Keep this product in its tightly closed original container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) place in an area that is inaccessible to children and animals. <u>Pesticide Disposal and Container Handling</u>: Do not puncture or incinerate. Non refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container *If empty:* Place in trash or offer for recycling, if available. *If partly filled*: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
