The application referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable with the following comments:

1. You must update your label according to PR Notice 2008-1. Please change "Do not apply directly to any body of water." to read "To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area."

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING: Remove protective cap, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches. Remove birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed

before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.
INDOORS: FLIES, HOUSEFLIES, FRUIT FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, WASPS, HORNETS, BEES: Close all doors and windows and direct INDOORS: FILES, HOUSEFILES, FRUIT FILES, MOSQUITGES, GNATS, WASPS, HORNETS, BEES: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Direct spray to all parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Keep nozzle in constant motion. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep and discard fallen insects. COCKROACHES, WATERBUGS, PALMETTO BUGS, SILVERHSH, CRICKETS, SCORPIONS, SPIDERS, MILLIPEDES: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. ANTS: Spray traits, nests and points of entry. Spray directly on ants where possible. CARPET BEETLES: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves, and carpets. OUTDOORS: Point spray nozzle away from face. Hold can on slight downward angle. For best results, spray when air is calm. Allow a few minutes for product to take effect. Spray with wind if breeze is blowing. Remove all exposed food and cooking utensils. Cover food handling surfaces or wash thoroughly after treatment or before use. Do not use on edible crops. Hying insects: Hies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Small Flying Moths, Hornets, Wasps and Yellow Jackets. Allow fog to drift over area. Direct spray toward bushes, or grass from at least 4 to 6 feet away. Cive special attention to breeding areas such as garbage cans and compost piles. Mud daubers and wasp nests: Spray mist directly on insects and their nests from approximately 2 feet away. Contacted insects will fly away from fog. Applications should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray into hiding and breeding places contacting as many insects as possible. Carwling insects: Ants, Cockroaches, including Asian Cockroaches, Crickets, Mole Crickets, Centipedes, and Silverfish. Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, wetting as man

May also be used on other plants such as African violets, asters, azaleas, begonias, camellias, carnations, chrysanthenums, dehlias, delphiniums, dogwood, English by, euonymus, fuschia, geraniums, crassula, grape vine, Kentia palm, laurel, merigolds, rhododendrons, roses, rubber plants, snapdragons, stocks, wandering jews, and zinnias. Effective when used as directed against WHITEFLIES, APHIDS, SPIDERS, AND RED MITES, EXPOSED THRIPS, LACE BUGS, JAPANESE BEETLES, PAVEMENT ANTS, CLOVER MITES AND ABMYWORMS. When spraying plants, do not operate closer than 18 inches; Use sweeping motion. Spray in one second bursts. Be cautious about wetting tender foliage, young plants, and new growth. Do not spray plants when temp, exceeds 90 °F. Over application might cause damage. Contact insects directly whenever possible. Repeat treatment as infestations occur

TICKS[Adults and Larvae]: Remove and thoroughly clean and replace pet bedding. Spray pet sleeping quarters, bed, floor and floor covering with special attention to cracks and crevices around base boards and window and door frames. Intested upholstered furniture and mattresses may be treated with this product. Allow all sprayed articles to dry thoroughly before use. CARPET BEETLES: Spray directly on beetles, floors, baseboards, shelves, and carpets. COCKROACHES, WATERBUGS, PALMETTO BUGS, SILVERISH, FIREBRATS, CRICKETS, SCORPIONS, MILLIPEDES, SOWBUGS, and PILLBUGS: Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible. ANTS: Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray directly on ants where possible.


FLEAS IN HOMES - Space spray: Hold can 3 inches above floor and direct spray toward floor and lower walls at a rate of 10 seconds per 100 sq. ft. making sure that all floor, sofe and chair surfaces are contacted. Leave room and keep area closed for 15 minutes. Open and ventilate before respraying. Allow all treated areas to dry thoroughly before use. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed. Do not use in rooms/areas while occupied by patients, the elderly or infirm.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool, dry area. Do not transport or store below 32°F. Do not incinerate or puncture. IF EMPTY: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.
