GENERAL WASHING

If you soak clothes, add one tablespoonful of Snoboy to each gallon of warm or hot water, rinse, wash as usual, with soap powders in your own machine or tub. To bleach white linens, mix 1 tablespoonful to each gallon of warm or hot water and soak clothes for ten minutes, rinse well.

TO REMOVE STAINS

Dip white cotton or linen in cold water first to remove starch. Add half cupful of Snoboy to a gallon of warm water, soak articles for ten minutes, rinse.

SNOBOY REMOVES

Ink, iodine, mildew, vegetable, coffee, citrus, wine, scorch, blood, nicotine. If brown stains from ink remain, remove with lemon juice or orange.

AS A CLEANSER, DISINFECTANT, DEODORANT FOR THE FOLLOWING

Wash and cleanse surfaces thoroughly with a suitable detergent, then apply solution of 3 tablespoonfuls of Snoboy to a quart of warm or cold water, let stand 5 to 15 minutes, then rinse the surface if necessary.

Bath tubs and basins, bottles, chopping blocks, rockery, coffee and tea pots, drain boards, cuspidors, decanters, cut glass, dishes, sinks, tile, vases, windows, wood work, marble, porcelain, enamel ware.

Do not use on silk or wool.
Keep in cool place.

DIRECTIONS

General Cleaning

Pour half cupful Snoboy into bucket; swish solution over all inside surfaces. Add two teaspoonfuls vinegar, let stand for 15 minutes, then rinse.

REFRIGERATORS

Wash inside surfaces of shelves, rinse with solution two tablespoonfuls Snoboy to quart of warm water, let stand 15 minutes, rinse with clear water, dry, air.

CANAGE CANS

Wash with hot water, rinse, then wash thoroughly with solution of 3 tablespoonfuls Snoboy to each quart warm water, let stand five minutes; rinse, dry.

WASHED NYLONS

To brighten nylons add two tablespoonfuls of Snoboy to each quart of warm water, then add one teaspoonful of vinegar. Mix well. Soak nylons for 30 minutes and rinse well.

CAUTION

Diluted Snoboy bleach will irritate skin or eyes. Rinse immediately. If accidentally taken internally, feed cooked cereal followed by salad oil. Call doctor.

Do not use in copper, aluminum or iron vessels. Use in porcelain or enamel lined vessel.

GENERAL WASHING

For clothes, add 1/2 cupful of Snoboy to 1 gallon of warm water. Wash with soap powder. Avoid boiling. For tablecloths, add 1/2 cupful of Snoboy to 1 gallon of water and soak clothes.

TO REMOVE STAINS

Wash in cold water. Add 1/2 cupful of Snoboy to 1 quart of water. Soak five to ten minutes.

SNOBOY REMOVES

Stains from coffee, cocoa, citrus fruit, and other liquids. Wash with vinegar.

AS A CLEANSER, DISINFECTANT, DEODORANT FOR THE FOLLOWING

1/2 cupful of Snoboy per gallon of water.

DIRECTIONS

General Cleansing

TOILET BOWLS

Pour half cupful Snoboy into bowl, wash over all inside surfaces, then add two tablespoonfuls vinegar, let stand hour or overnight.

REFRIGERATORS

Wash inside surfaces and shelves with solution two tablespoonfuls Snoboy to 1 quart of water, let stand five minutes, rinse with clean water, dry, air.

GARBAGE CANS

Wash with hot suds, rinse, then wash thoroughly with solution three tablespoonfuls Snoboy to 1 quart warm water, let stand five minutes, air dry.

YELLOWED NYLONS

To brighten yellowed nylons, add two tablespoonfuls Snoboy Bleach to 1 quart of water. Wash, then add one tablespoonful vinegar. Machine wash nylons 20 minutes and rinse well.

CAUTION

Undiluted Snoboy bleach will irritate skin or eyes. Rinse immediately if accidentally taken internally. Feed only on case, followed by salad oil, then doctor.

Do not use in copper, aluminum or tin vessels. Use in porcelain or enamel-lined vessels.
