- Revision to Precautionary Statements
- Other minor revisions

Conditions

1. Add the following statement beneath the "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS, HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS" heading: "CAUTION: Harmful if absorbed through the skin. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling."

A stamped copy of the labeling accepted with conditions is enclosed. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed label before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

2. FIBERGLASS AND MODERN SURFACES

3. STOVETOPS, RANGES, POTS & PANS

Apply directly to greasy soils, scour and rinse. Repeat if needed. DO NOT USE ON SILVER, ALUMINUM OR RUBBER ITEMS.

Flush toilet [or] first. Apply above waterline and under and around rim of bowl (4 oz). Let soak 10 minutes, swab [or] brush all surfaces thoroughly and flush.
