The revised draft label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable, provided that you comply with the following conditions:

1. In the subscript to the ingredient statement you list the inerts by general phrases and generic names. If you list one generic chemical name you must list all inerts by generic name. If you list by stating phrases like "cleansing agent" then all inclusions should be so generally stated. Revise this postscript to the ingredient statement accordingly or delete the entire statement.
2. Two copies of the finished printed label must be submitted to the Agency before the product is released for shipment as required by PR Notice 82-2 of June 18, 1982. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a description of finished printed labeling.
3. The finished labels must comply with the general labeling requirements of section 162.10 of Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations. If the label does not satisfy these requirements it will be rejected.

A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.



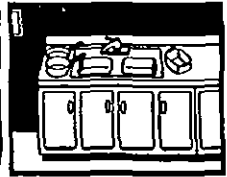
