1. Incorporate the following biodegradability claim:

"Contains biodegradable surfactant"

in with the inert ingredients substatement and remove the claim from the back panel. Please note that this statement must not be highlighted (e.g. all capital letters).

2. Change the statements:

"CONTAINS NO PHOSPHOROUS" CONTAINS NO CHLORINE BLEACH OR AMMONIA"

to read:

"Contains no phosphorous Contains no chlorine bleach or ammonia

The statements may not be highlighted (eg. all capital letters) and should be in the same type size as the other text in the label.
