

Dear Ms. Mitchell:

Per PR Notice 2007-4, The Procter & Gamble Company is submitting the following notification for the addition of container disposal language identical to that contained in 40 CFR 156.140. Under the 40 CFR 156.140(5)(xi), this product qualifies for the exemption for the first two required statements. This is because the metal lid is crimped onto the fiberboard can, and it would be destroyed if reuse of the container was attempted. The recycling/reconditioning statement (proposed update) will be added to the packaging once approved, along with the existing batch code.

The change proposed is as follows:
