 - b. Above the directions for use, where it says, "Safely cleans porcelain," change "porcelain" to "glazed porcelain," and change "ceramic" to "glazed ceramic."
 - c. Replace the first three lines of the precautionary paragraph with the following:

Harmful if absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Causes eye irritation. Prolonged or frequently repeated contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals.

- d. Place the following statements under a separate "First Aid" or "Practical Treatment" heading:

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

- e. Place the entire statement, "See Back Panel For Other Precautions," underneath the signal word CAUTION.
- f. Delete the name "Dipropylene glycol butyl ether." (One inert ingredient may not be listed by specific chemical name without the others also being listed.)

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
