In accordance with PR Notice 98-10, this provides the Agency notification of a new package design for Mr. Clean Multi-Surfaces Antibacterial (EPA Reg. No. 3573-63).

The package design will change from the separate front and back labels that are currently affixed onto the Mr. Clean bottle to a two-sided front label. The back label text will be clearly visible to consumers through the back of the bottle. Mr. Clean Multi-Surfaces Antibacterial is currently available as a limited disinfectant in the Summer Citrus scent, which is a yellow liquid. The back label text is clearly legible through the yellow product liquid contained in the clear PETE plastic bottle.

There will be no changes to the label text or graphics with this new package design. The only change is the transition from two separate product labels (front / back) to a two-sided front label.
