- b) On the front panel of the label, delete the term/word germs” wherever it appears. This term is too broad to use on a non-public health product.
 - c) On the back panel of your label, under FABRIC SAFETY, replace the word “safe”. You can use “will not harm” or similar wording.
 - d) Revise your First Aid statement to read: “If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.”
3. By March 31, 2002, you must submit a 21 day dermal toxicity study using this end-use product. Refer to our letter dated July 24, 2000 on this product for further details on why the 21-day dermal study is required. If the data are not found to be acceptable, this registration may expire according to the “Term of Issuance”.

This conditional registration will expire automatically on January 31, 2003. You should note that if you fail to satisfy the conditions imposed in this registration, EPA may issue a notice to cancel this registration under FIFRA 6 (e).
