- b. **Revise the scientific nomenclature for “*Salmonella choleraesuis*” to “*Salmonella enterica*”, effective immediately.**
- c. In accordance with DIS/TSS-17 requirements, revise the proposed label to include the major areas where the product is used by stating “homes, hotels, schools, and restaurants.”
- d. In accordance with DIS/TSS-15 requirements, you must add deodorizing and cleaning directions to the label that state the following:

To Deodorize/Clean: Use the WetJet Mop to spray the floor until its thoroughly wet. Remove excess liquid.
- e. Under the “First Aid” statement, revise the phrase, “gently rinse with water” to read “gently with water.”
- f. Revise the 30th claim by deleting “Cougar” and stating “Snipe.”
- g. Revise the 30th, 31st, 33rd, 37th and 38th claims by deleting the term, “safe,” and state “Will not harm.”
- h. Revise the 20th thru 25th claim by deleting the phrase, “prevents the spread of,”.


3. You must add Child Resistant Packaging based on the acute toxicity studies cited in support of this product’s registration. You must submit a certification statement to the Agency that this product’s packaging meets the standards of 40 CFR 157.32 prior to selling of distributing this product.

Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before distributing or selling the product bearing the revised labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

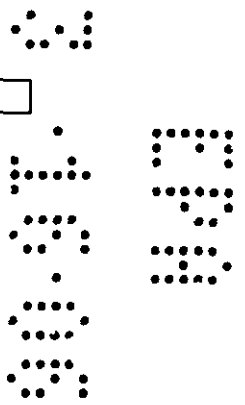

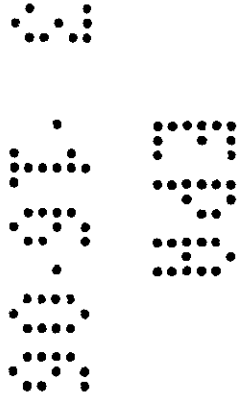
