



DIRECTIONS FOR USE

HOUSEHOLD INSECTS: Use 3 tablespoons of this product in 1 qt. of water, and apply as a coarse spray or brush around window frames, baseboards, drain boards, under sink, and stoves, cracks, and crevices to control ants, spiders, silverfish, crickets, clover mites, and earwigs. Be careful not to contaminate food or utensils. Water base sprays may stain finished surfaces. Repeat application as necessary.

FLY CONTROL: Spray all surfaces where flies alight or congregate, dwellings, out buildings, animal quarters, poultry houses, manure piles, garbage heaps and city dumps, with a solution containing one half pint per 3 gallons of water.

Do not use in edible products areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed.
