Zylstra Dairy Backrubber Concentrate is especially formulated as an insecticide for use in mechanical oilers. Its use for dairy livestock will assure adequate control of horn flies with a minimum of attention from the herdsman and with a minimum amount of insecticide.

DIRECTIONS

Add 1 gallon of Zylstra Dairy Backrubber Concentrate to 4 gallons of kerosene, deodorized base oil or diesel oil. Place the ~~oil~~ backrubber device where animals congregate. Apply the diluted insecticide to the oiling device. Add more diluted insecticide from time to time as needed. Do not use on young x calves.

CAUTION

Avoid prolonged or repeated inhalation of mist and contact with the skin. In case of contact with skin or eyes, flush with plenty of water. For eyes get medical attention. Keep away from open flame. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Do not contaminate feed, water or foodstuffs. Keep Out of the Reach of Children. If swallowed, induce vomiting immediately and get medical attention. Atropine is antidotal.
