Subject: Amendment-Label Revisions
Residual Spray No. 2
EPA Registration No. 3624-126
Your Applications Dated August 3, 1984 and
August 20, 1985

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA as amended, is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- a. Change commas within chemical name for diazinon to hyphens and close up words.
- b. Correct "Posion" in Poison Control Center.
- c. Change "atrophine" to "atropine" in Note to Physician.
- d. Add "Container Disposal" heading in Storage and Disposal section.
- e. Add comma after "Before spraying an area."
- f. The term "Product zones" is not clear. Change to "tables, benches, and other areas where food is processed, prepared or held."
- g. Delete period after "Cadelles."

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h. Add to the Directions for Use "Do not use as a space spray."

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS
CAUTION**

Do not eat if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Avoid inhalation of mist or vapors. Wash hands after using and before eating or smoking. DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Continued)

Sanitation: Good sanitation is necessary for good insect control. Before spraying an area all debris from wrappings, food ingredients, food wastes or whatever should be removed and destroyed. All food utensils and baking ingredients—or candy ingredients—or food to be processed—should be removed or covered. Product zones or zones which may become product zones should be covered.

FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS: Places other than private residences in which exposed food is held, processed or prepared. Do not use in serving area while food is exposed. Equipment that can deliver a pin stream of insecticide must be used for crack and crevice treatment. A coarse wet spray using a fan type nozzle would not be appropriate for this type of treatment.

APPLICATIONS OF THIS PRODUCT IN THE FOOD AREAS OF FOOD HANDLING ESTABLISHMENTS, OTHER THAN AS A CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ARE NOT PERMITTED.

Prior to application de-energize electrical equipment. After application, allow time for oil to evaporate before starting motors or placing switches in the "ON" position.

FOOD AREAS LIMITED TO (CRACK AND CREVICE TREATMENT ONLY): Includes areas for receiving, serving, storage, packing (canning, bottling, wrapping, boxing) preparing, edible waste storage and enclosed processing systems (mills, dairies, edible oils, syrups). Apply Residual Spray No. 2 in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices using a pin stream of insecticide in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases, conduits, motor housings, junction or switch boxes, where Roaches, Flies, Silverfish hide. Care should be taken to avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air.

To aid in the control of STORED FOOD PESTS: Granary Weevils, Rice Weevils, Saw-toothed Weevils, Flat Grain Beetles, Indian Meal Moths, Confused Flour Beetles, Caddisflies, that would be exposed at the time of application. Spray with special attention to cracks, niches, crevices and other hiding places. Spray around and under pallets so as to directly contact the pests with spray. To avoid sources of reinfestation, wormy flour, grain and cereals should be destroyed before treatment. **REPEAT APPLICATION AS NEEDED.**

NON-FOOD AREAS (SPOT APPLICATION): Includes garbage rooms, lavatories, floor drains (to sewers), entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, garages, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling). Apply coarse spray to point of run off to baseboard areas, around water pipes, surfaces behind and beneath sinks, lockers, tables, toilets and similar areas where insects hide or through which they may enter.

Food processing plants which have pipe tunnels through which steam and other utilities enter the building from outside should have this tunnel sprayed thoroughly, top, bottom, walls and pipes. Insulated pipes are a favorite hiding place for roaches.

To aid in the control of carpet beetles make repeated applications to baseboards, corners and other such surfaces where these insects tend to congregate.
