The second subheading would then be "LIVESTOCK" [perhaps with a listing of acceptable animals, if you choose] and the associated text advising outdoor treatment plus the precautions about washing and consecutive DDVP exposures. Please submit five (5) copies of the actual finished (printed) label as soon as it becomes available.
