The amendments referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, are acceptable. The Agency's records have been adjusted to show the change in product name to "Dairy and Stock Spray". The updated formula statement showing the identity of suppliers has been added to this product's registration file. When printing the actual finished labels, please divide the Electric and Stationary Foggers directions into two subsections. The first should bear the subheading BARNs and should include the sentence "Fog about 2 fluid ozs. of spray per 1000 cubic feet." directly after ".... to kill resting adult flies.". The second subheading would then be "LIVESTOCK" [perhaps with a listing of acceptable animals, if you choose] and the associated text advising outdoor treatment plus the precautions about washing and consecutive DDVP exposures. Please submit five (5) copies of the actual finished (printed) label as soon as it becomes available.

A stamped copy of the updated label is enclosed for your records.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

WARNING

May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Do not breathe vapor or spray mist. DO NOT apply in combination with trichlorofon. DO NOT use on Brahman or Brahman cross cattle, as they may show hypersensitivity to organic phosphates.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. DO NOT apply directly to water or wetlands. DO NOT contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS:

FLAMMABLE. Do not smoke while using. Do not use, pour, spill or store near heat or open flame. Flash Point; 125°F.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Prohibitions: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

Pesticide Disposal: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Storage: Store in a cool dry area away from heat or open flame. Keep container closed.

Metal Containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

Plastic Containers: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill or incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
